

### Value of Non-Financial Support: \$3,742,677

Non-financial support includes the quantifiable value of food, clothing, housewares and other necessities provided to our neighbors.

These items are given through Food Pantry and Thrift Store vouchers.

Here's what our Food Programs (the largest support program) saw in 2024:

**49,244 people assisted** through the Food Pantry;

**63,291 pounds** of fresh produce distributed during the Fresh Food for Families program;



By using the Food Pantry, families can realize an estimated \$207 per month in cost savings so they can allocate funds toward other critical expenses.
